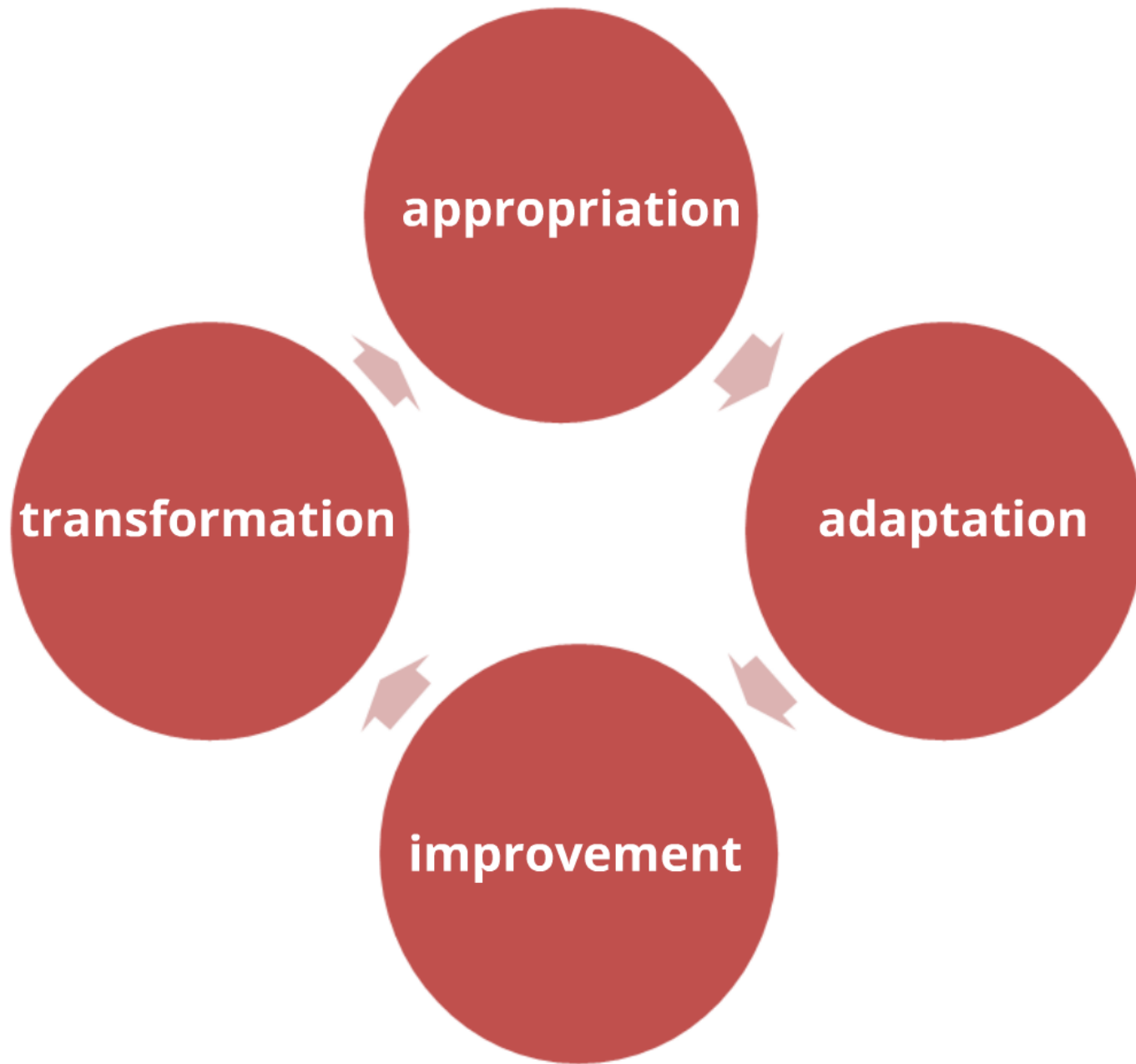

Everything remains the same.

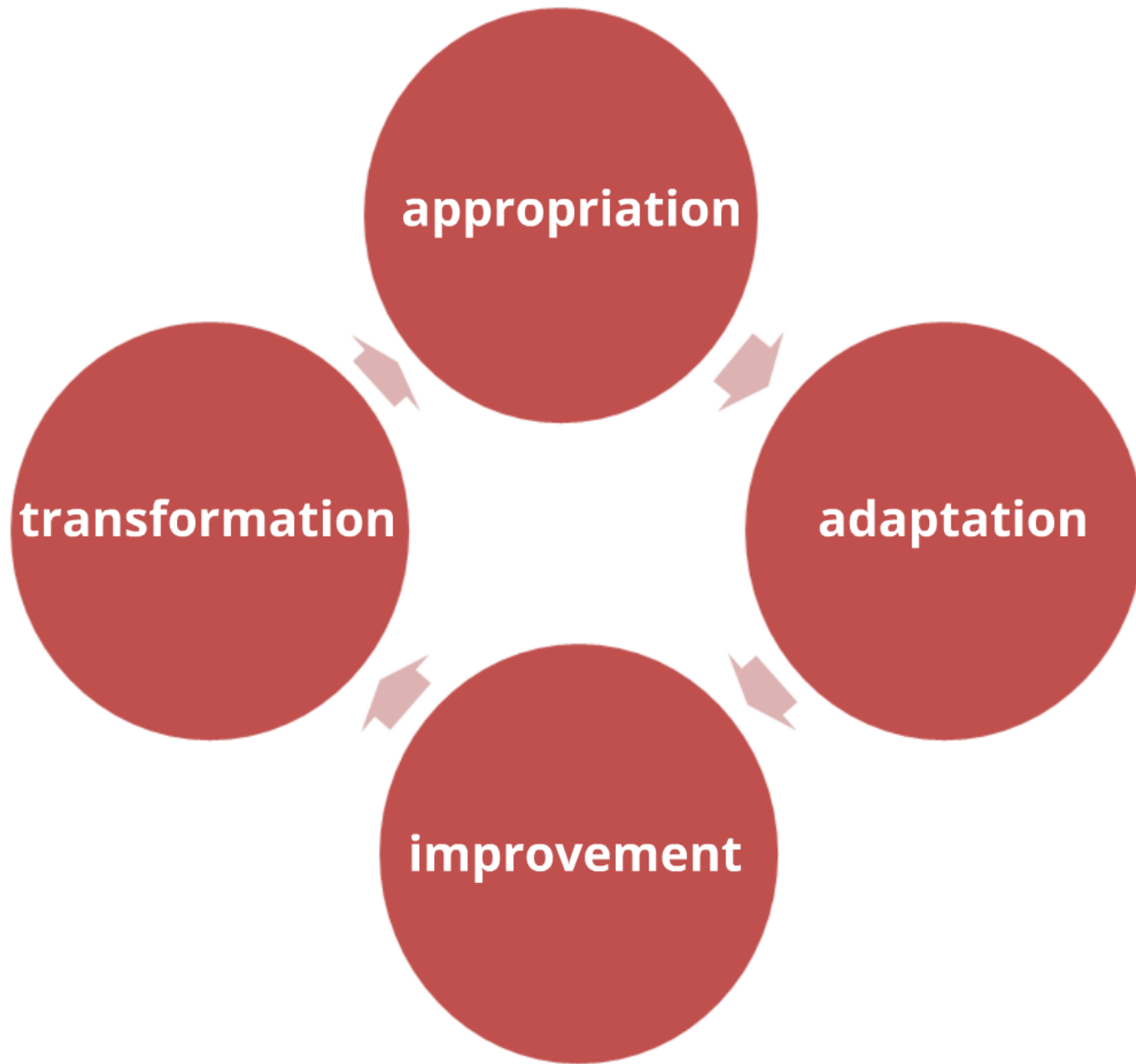
errrr Supervision

a digitization of processes.

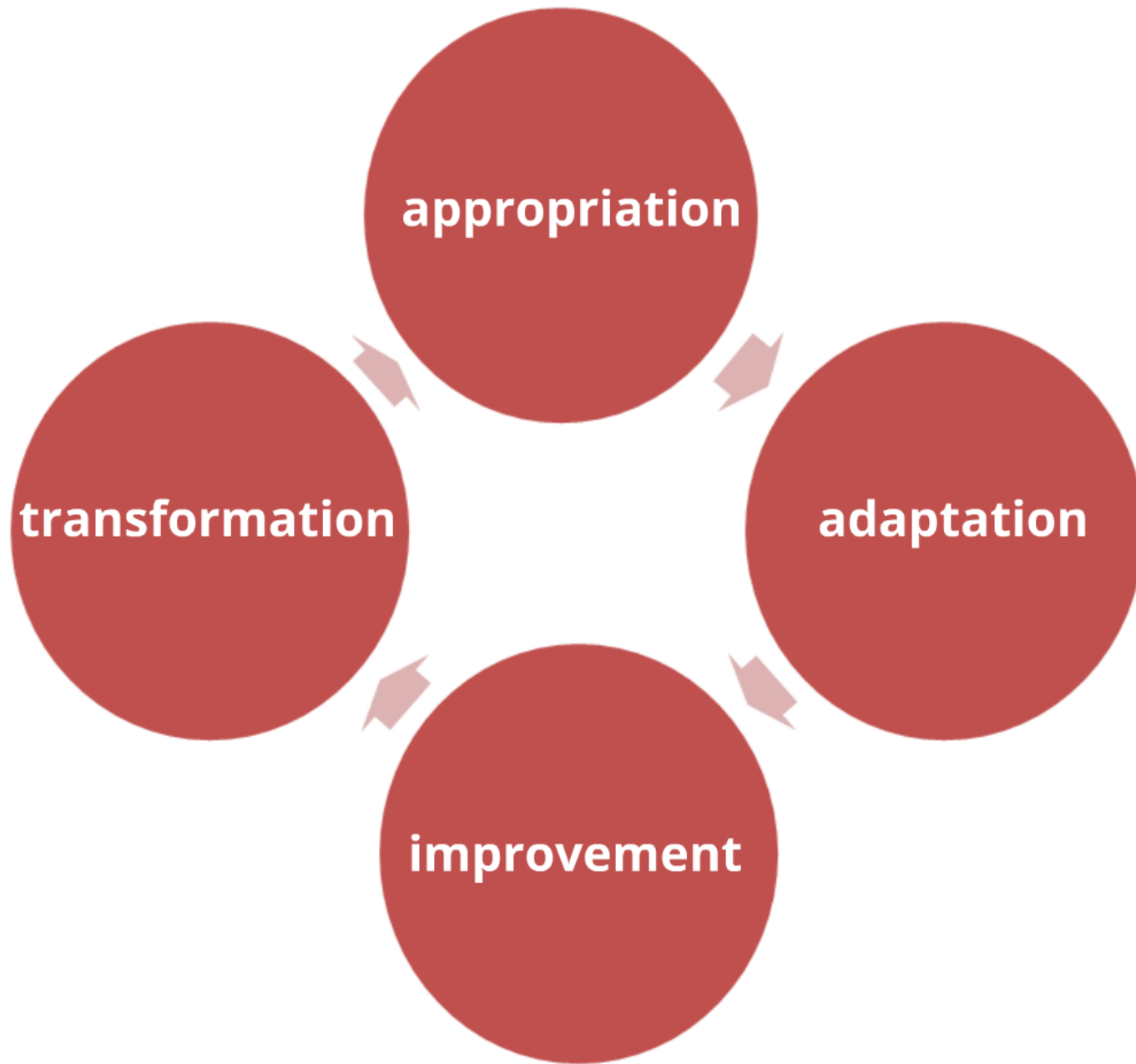
electronic Supervision

A necessary step.

Costs may outweigh benefits.

Investments vs. expenditures.

Get over barriers of time+space.

to capture some benefits.

Communities work collaboratively.

New (international) actors:

- LMS, virtual classroom, xMOOC
- Communities of Learning

evolved Supervision

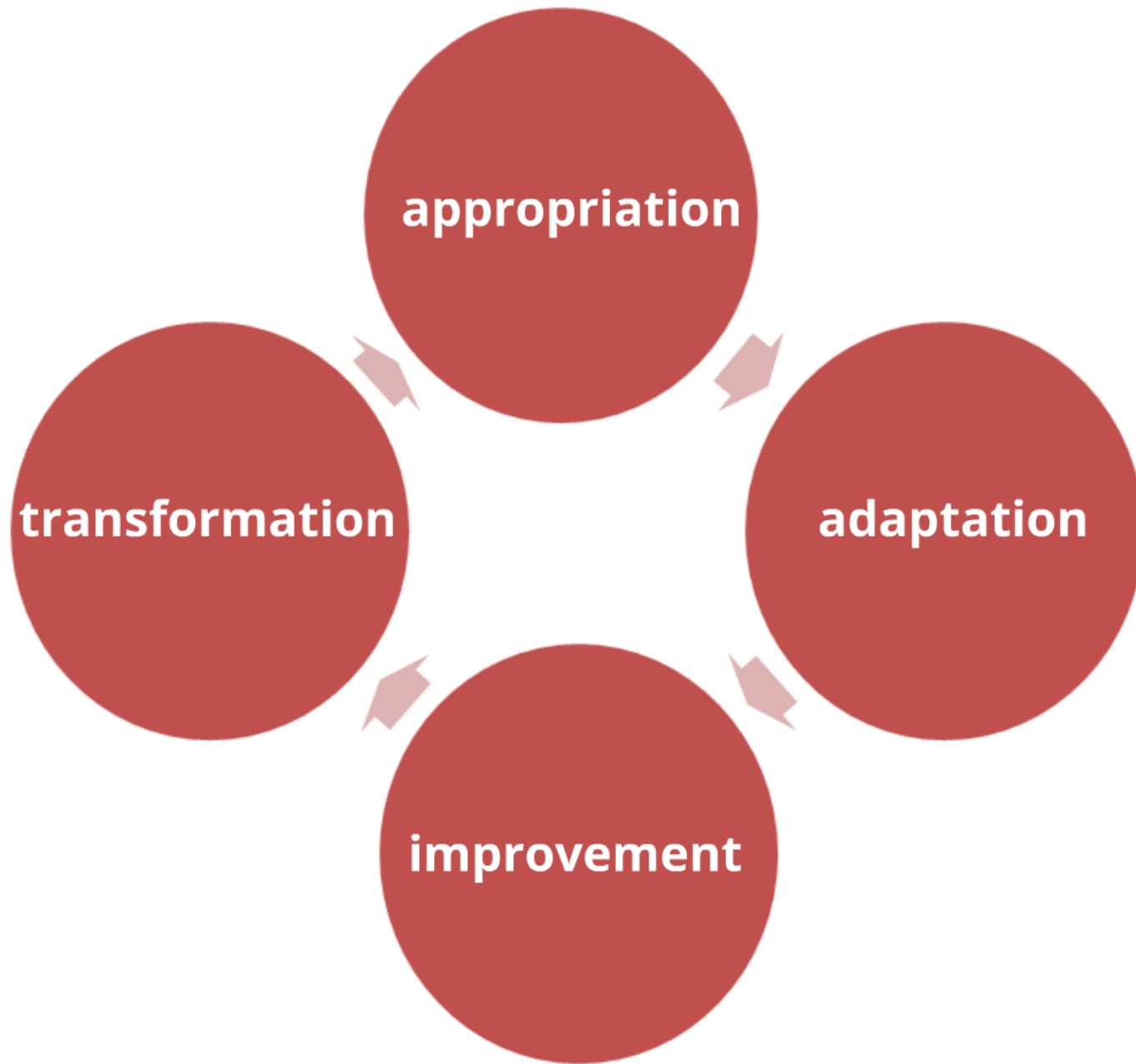
An intermediate goal.

Benefits outweigh costs.

New (international) actors:

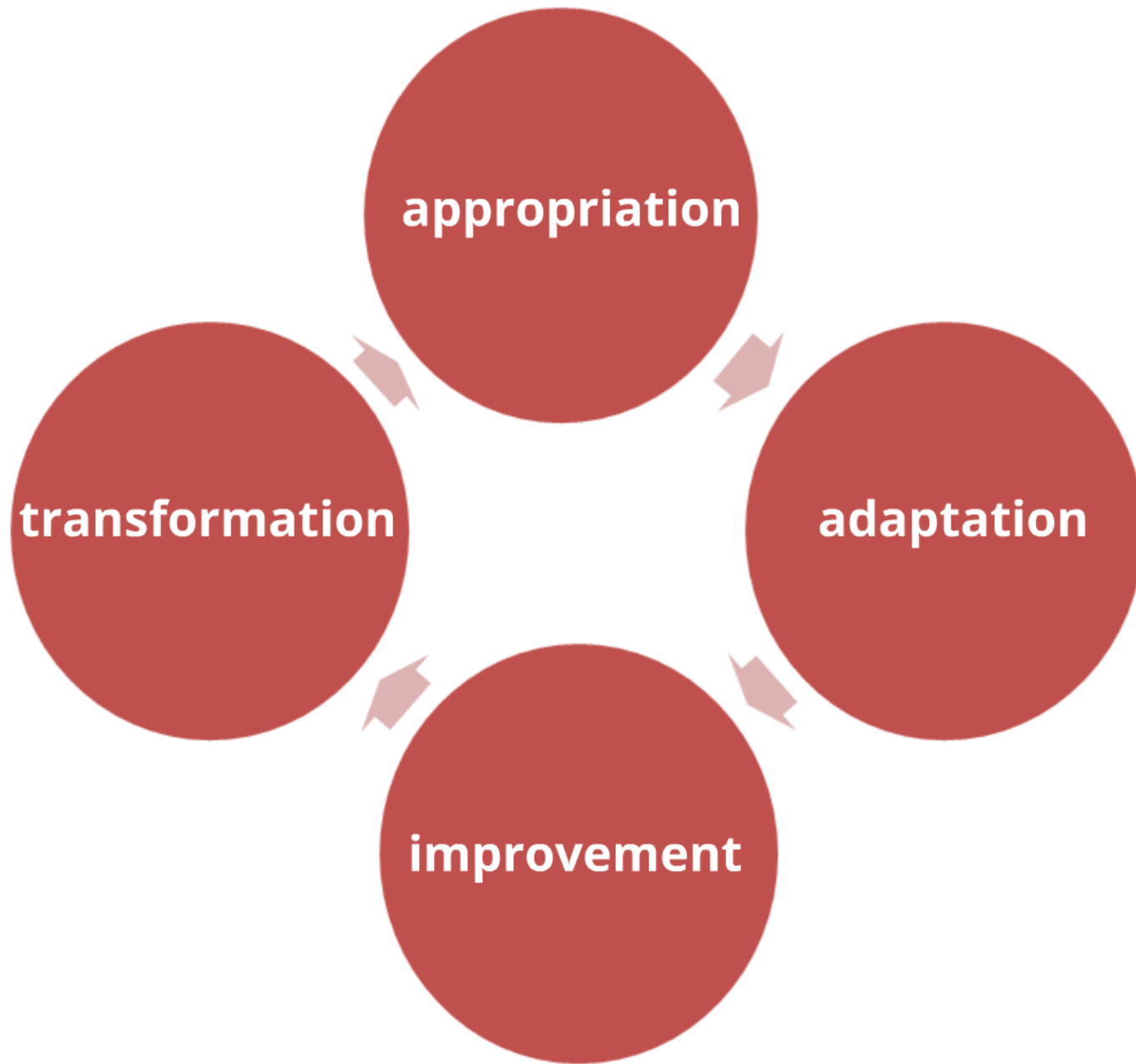
- Personal Learning Environment
